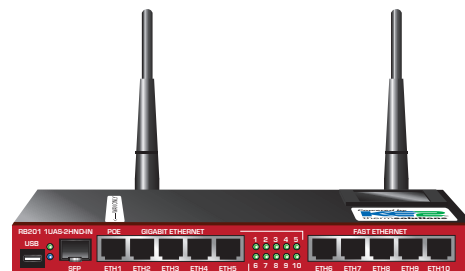
KE2 SmartGate launches - provides easier networking of KE2 Evap

KE2 Therm's new industrial grade router, the KE2 SmartGate is the heart of the refrigeration network. It provides exceptional value by simplifying configuration and bringing the horsepower to run most customers' entire network.

The sensitive nature of refrigeration systems require security to protect them from unintended access. The KE2 SmartGate's pre-installed Virtual Private Network (VPN) provides the ability to control who has access, as well as the ability to remove access, if needed.

With nine ports available to connect the KE2 Evap controllers, the need for an additional switch is greatly reduced. A stronger wireless signal allows easier controller access over longer distances and in noisier environments. The KE2 SmartGate ships in a rugged aluminum case with significantly expanded operating range, for harsher environments.

All in all, the KE2 SmartGate packs hundreds of dollars of additional features in a neat, clean package.
